Listen to everyone, and respect all opinions.

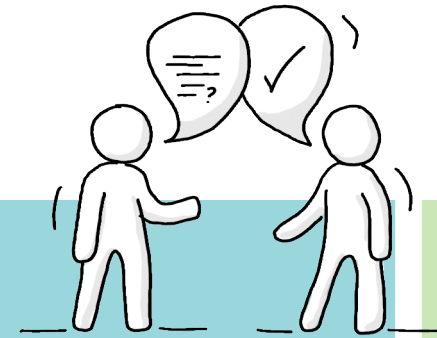
Come with an open mind.

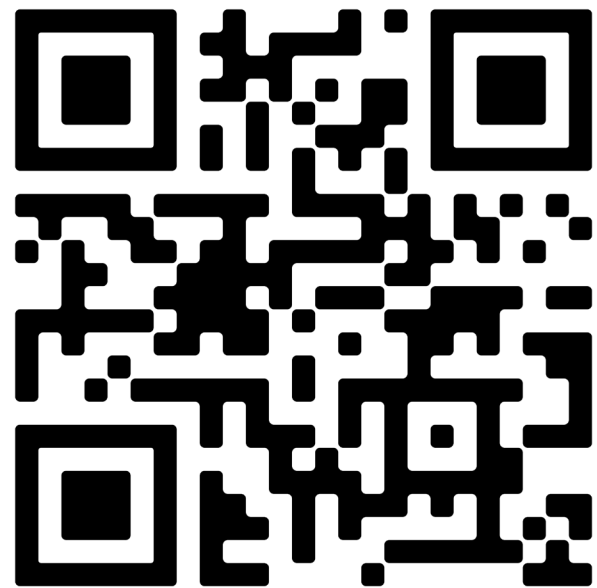
